There will be a variety of dogs in all shapes, sizes and breeds. This is a great opportunity to show everyone how amazing a shelter dog can be and the importance of adoption. YOU can play a key role by becoming a foster parent for our Best in Show participants!

If you would like to foster a 2018 Best in Show Dog, here are three things you should know:

Foster dogs MUST PARTICIPATE in Best in Show!

Each dog chosen for Best in Show remains the property of The Animal Foundation and is committed to being a part of the show. The Foster department will provide details about the opportunity to adopt your foster dog at the event, should you be interested. Adopting your foster dog prior to the event is not permitted under any circumstances.

Fostering a Best in Show dog means committing to a few extra duties...

At no or minimal cost to you, foster parents for Best in Show dogs are required to:

- Complete a Doggie Personality Survey no later than Monday, March 26th – tell us what makes your dog stand out!
- Schedule a photography session and transport your foster dog to and from appointment (photographer and available schedule will be provided at time of foster dog pick-up)
- Keep all appointments with The Animal Foundation clinic for vaccinations
- Have your Best in Show foster dog groomed no sooner than a week prior to the show on Sunday, April 22nd (participating groomers will be provided at time of foster dog pick-up)

All information above will be provided to you once your future foster dog becomes available.

On the day of Best in Show (Sunday, April 22, 2018), foster parents must bring their foster dogs to the Thomas and Mack Center @ UNLV check-in point between 11am and 12pm.
